THE STRAWBRIDGE FAMILY GALLERY

The Wyeth Circle

Paintings in this gallery highlight the work of the broader spectrum of Wyeth family artists. The works of N.C. Wyeth's daughters Henriette, Carolyn, and Ann feature prominently. In addition, there are paintings by artists who worked alongside the Wyeths, including Henriette's husband, Peter Hurd, and Ann's husband, John W. McCoy. Also on view is the work of George A. Weymouth, the Brandywine's founder, who was a life-long friend of the family and was married for a time to N.C. Wyeth's granddaughter, the artist Anna Brelsford

McCoy. Exhibited together, these landscapes and portraits reveal the cross-currents of inspiration among the artists in the Wyeth circle.

Even as these artists developed their own styles and specialties, the influences upon one another are apparent in a variety of ways. The close up study of nature, appearing to burst forth from the painted surface is seen in several works. Portraits by three family members allow thoughtful comparison of each artist's choices. Among all of the artists, there is evidence of their attention to the lesson passed down from Howard Pyle to N.C. Wyeth: paint what you know best. Looking around the gallery, we

see the growth and development of the Wyeth circle of close friends and family throughout the twentieth century.








Carolyn Wyeth (1909-1994)








Henriette Wyeth (1907-1997)




Henriette Wyeth (1907-1997)




