

BIKE THE BRANDYWINE Saturday, September 20, 2025

Since 1967, the Brandywine Conservancy has worked to protect open space and water resources to help preserve water quality for local communities. Today, more than 70,200 acres of open space have been permanently protected thanks to our efforts, including more than 36,000 acres located within the Brandywine Creek Greenway. A regional planning initiative of the Conservancy, the Greenway encompasses one National Historic Park, one state Scenic Byway, three major state parks, 40+ municipal parks, 69 miles of trails and sidewalks, and the Brandywine Creek—a major source of drinking water for nearly half a million people. Program defines a single powerful vision of how people in the region wish to live, work and play.



First held in 2016, **Bike the Brandywine** celebrates the landscapes and vistas that make up the Greenway and introduces cyclists to the organization that ensures their perpetual protection. Over 450 riders and volunteers participated in the 6th Bike the Brandywine in 2024, and we expect that number to increase in 2025 with 500-600 riders and volunteers. After having to cancel the 2023 ride due to extreme weather, 2024's ride was a perfect day for a ride.

In September 2025, Bike the Brandywine will once again feature three loops that take in the beautiful Brandywine Creek Greenway and surrounding countryside. With distances of 25, 45, and 62 miles (the last, a "metric century")—each ride offers a unique and thrilling experience for both recreational and more avid/seasoned cyclists. After the ride, participating cyclists will enjoy food, drink and merriment with their fellow riders in a post-ride event to include additional opportunities for sponsor advertising and acknowledgement.
