About Radnor Hunt Races

The 2026 Radnor Hunt Races will be a celebration of <u>95</u> years of horseracing on the Main Line. With everything from amazing tailgates, fancy hats and bow ties to the parade of antique carriages and thoroughbreds racing for the finish, Radnor Hunt Races is a day filled with elegance, excitement, and fun. Race day is about steeplechase racing, it's about fashion, and it's about tradition! Most importantly, it's about 10,000 friends and family supporting the protection of open space and clean water in our region.



Brandywine Conservancy

In 1980, then Race Chair and philanthropist Elizabeth "Betty" Ranney Moran and conservationist and Brandywine Conservancy founder George "Frolic" Weymouth formed the partnership between the Races and the Conservancy as the race's sole beneficiary, highlighting the connection between equestrian pursuits and open space.

Since then, net proceeds from corporate tents and sponsorships; tent and tailgate reservations; and souvenir, program, and ad sales have supported the Conservancy's land and water protection efforts.

To date, the Race for Open Space has raised more than \$5.5 million in support of the Conservancy's open space and clean water programs and over 70,000 acres are permanently protected, including the Radnor Hunt racecourse itself and the surrounding lands.




Race Day Attendees

Steeplechase Audience

Steeplechase attendees are well-educated and affluent, with more than 90% of race fans having a college, graduate, or professional degree and 72% having incomes of over \$100,000 per year.

Local Reach (from 2025 Races)

- 92% of attendee sales came from the Philadelphia metro area with over 30% of sales from Chester County alone.
- 40% of sales came from the following zip codes alone: Malvern, PA; Wayne, PA; Berwyn, PA; Newtown Square, PA; and Devon, PA. All are ranked in the top 1,000 wealthiest zip codes in the U.S.* with a median household income between \$100,000 and \$200,000.**
- About 62% of attendees were loyal returning patrons from the 2024 Radnor Hunt Races.

Audience Reach

Website

RadnorHuntRaces.org had close to 16,000 unique user visits and over 34,000 website views in 2025, which is roughly a 14% increase from website views in 2024.

Social

The Radnor Hunt Races was highlighted in over 100 Facebook and Instagram posts between January and June 2025, creating about 650,000 impressions, roughly 80,000 more impressions than in 2024. Close to 24,000 users engaged with those posts, which was about a 20% increase from 2024.

Emails

Six dedicated emails were sent out to the Radnor Hunt Races distribution list with over 3,800 unique email addresses. Radnor Hunt Races was featured in more than ten Brandywine event emails, which reached over 30,000 unique contacts.


