

Please note that deer resistant doesn't mean deer proof! Plus, some plants fall prey to other wildlife like groundhogs and rabbits.

Several plant species have a wide range of growing conditions. For example, some plants can handle shade, but bloom better in full sun. Remember, you can always move your plants!

The National Wildlife Federation has a Native Plant Finder tool that will help landowners identify which plants are native to their zip code and what species of butterflies and moths are known to utilize those plants, at genus level, as hosts for their caterpillars. Use it here: www.nwf.org/nativeplantfinder/.
